

**TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY INTO THE ACT ANNUAL DINNER 2011 PRIZE DRAW  
ON BEHALF OF RED BALLOON LEARNER CENTRE GROUP AND THE ACT  
EDUCATIONAL TRUST**

- (1) The promoter of the prize is ACT (Administration) Limited (the "ACT") of 51 Moorgate, London, EC2R 6BH and [Red Balloon Learner Centre Group – 7a Chesterton Mill, French's Road, Cambridge, CB4 3NP ("Red Balloon")
- (2) Red Balloon is a Registered Charity, Number 1109606. The aim of Red Balloon is the recovery of bullied children. Individual Learner Centres provide an 'intensive care' full-time academic and therapeutic programme for children aged 10 to 17 who cannot go to school because they have been severely bullied. Red Balloon Learner Centre Group raise funds to set up new Learner Centres, raise public awareness of the need for such provision, and oversee the running of the Centres
- (3) The prize monies will be split 90% to Red Balloon and 10% to the ACT Educational Trust
- (4) The prize is a helicopter ride for [up to four] people from Biggin Hill to either Le Touquet airport or Cornwall airport, plus lunch for up to four people up to a maximum of GBP £1,000 at a restaurant in either Le Touquet or Padstow
- (5) All costs other than the helicopter flight and the lunch must be met by the winner, including but not limited to transfers to and from the airport and accommodation
- (6) The helicopter outward and return flight must be taken on the same day
- (7) Red Balloon is responsible for booking the lunch. The winner must submit a receipt to Ria Robinson, Director of Membership & Company Secretary at the ACT to reclaim the cost of the lunch
- (8) All entries must be received by 2200hrs, 9 November 2011
- (9) The winner will be chosen at random by Dara O'Briain and the winner's name will be available on request
- (10) Employees, Council Members and Trustees of the ACT, The ACT Educational Trust and Red Balloon or their families are not allowed to enter the draw
- (11) The ACT and Red Balloon will announce the winner at the end of the Annual Dinner
- (12) The ACT and Red Balloon reserve the right to amend these rules at any time
- (13) The ACT and Red Balloon reserve the right to offer a cash alternative but this cannot be requested by the winner
- (14) The winner and their guests understand the risks associated with commercial air transport flight and agree that they must satisfy themselves in respect of any health issues and seek medical consent where necessary
- (15) If the flight is cancelled by Lanthwaite Aviation for weather or technical reasons the winner can reschedule the flight. Neither Red Balloon nor Lanthwaite Aviation will be liable to pay any accommodation or other transport costs. If the winner wishes to cancel the flight they must provide more than one week's notice. If less than one week's notice is provided by the winner the rescheduled flight will be scheduled at the convenience of Lanthwaite Aviation.

(17) The date of the helicopter flight is subject to the availability of the helicopter. Booking in advance will increase the likelihood of the required date being available. The helicopter flight and the lunch must be taken by 30 September 2012. If Lanthwaite Aviation cancels the flight this date can be extended.

(18) The winner agrees to take part in publicity for the ACT, Red Balloon and Lanthwaite Aviation

(19) The ACT is responsible for the provision of the lunch. Red Balloon is responsible for the provision of the helicopter ride. Neither the ACT nor Red Balloon shall be liable for any indirect or consequential loss, or loss of goodwill, loss of profits, loss of publicity, loss of business opportunity or any other economic loss or for any third party claims arising under or in connection with or as a result of the prize draw. The aggregate liability of the ACT and Red Balloon arising under or in connection with this prize draw shall be GBP500

(20) Neither Red Balloon nor the ACT shall in any circumstances be in breach of these terms and conditions nor liable for delay in performing, or failure to perform, any of its obligations under this Agreement if such delay or failure results from events, circumstances or causes beyond its reasonable control ("Force Majeure").
